## **BOOKS TO ART: SLEEPY SHEEPY**

#### Tuesday, June 3rd 10am-11am Ages 5-10 | \$14

Each class in "Books to Art" students read fun and silly children's books and then create art projects inspired by the stories. This session, children will read "Sleepy Sheepy and the Sheepover" by Lucy Ruth Cummins. They will then create a cotton ball sheep puppet.



## **BOOKS AND BEATS: MY SHADOW**

#### Friday, June 6th 9am-12pm Ages 6-11 | \$50

Children will read "My Shadow" by Robert Lewis Stevenson. After reading the poem, students will engage in art and music activities culminating in a final performance. In this fast paced camp, students will create shadow art, explore music and movement concepts using the topic of "shadows", and even discover the enchanting effects of a shadow screen!

## **ANYTHING BUT A BRUSH**

#### Saturday, June 21st 10am-1pm Ages 11-15 | \$40

Your challenge is to paint with anything but a brush! Explore how to build texture with odd objects and learn about other new painting tools. This class will help students build layers to a simple composition. Create different effects, lines, and apply paint differently than with a brush. Imperfect lines and experimentation are the key to this class.

### **PIGMENT PAINTING**

#### Saturday, July 19th 10am-12pm Ages 7-12 | \$35

Natural pigments are colored substances derived from natural sources like minerals and plants. This class will explore painting with naturally occurring pigments and their ph modifiers. No prior painting experience required! You'll create unique pieces of art with real turmeric, coffee, hibiscus, and more.



## **SUN COLLAGE**

Inspired by hot summer days, students will create their own colorful collages. In this class students will explore the medium of collage and create our own sunny collages. We'll learn about the use of color and repeated patterns in design and also practice those scissor skills.

## FAMILY BLACKOUT POETRY

#### Thursday, June 12th 6pm-8pm Ages 13-adult | \$15

Blackout poetry, or "erasure poetry" is the art of removing or crossing out words from an original text to create a new poem with what's left. This process is meditative, creative, and addicting. Your instructor will guide you through the process of making your poems. You'll then explore ways to "black out" your poetry other than a traditional marker.

#### **IMPROV QUILTING**

#### June 20th 6pm-8pm + June 21st 10am-4pm Ages 14-adult | \$100

Learn the basics of quilting with the fun improv process. You'll make your very own hand-quilted or tied wall hanging. Sewist and quilter Victoria Moore will walk you through the process of improv patchwork and assembling your quilt; students will learn to use scraps to create a one-of-a-kind piece and leave with it ready to adorn their wall.

## NATURAL DYEING WITH TURMERIC

#### July 19th 1pm-3pm Ages 5-adult | \$35

Learn the magic and alchemy of working with plant dyes! This workshop will work with the sunshine color of turmeric. Students will learn tying and folding techniques, and the beauty of the dyeing process. Every student will dye an item with turmeric to keep. This class is open to all ages 5 and up. Children 11 and younger will need an adult to accompany them.

## **BOTANICAL CYANOTYPES**

#### July 26th 1pm-3pm Ages 12-adult | \$40

Cyanotypes are a method of negative analog photography developed in 1842. In this workshop participants will learn the entire process of preparing the mix and prepping their surfaces for their works. Participants will then explore making cyanotype prints with pressed plants and flowers to create unique and personal pieces of art.
