KIDS MULTI-WEEK COURSES

Clay For Kids

Ages 5-10 Instructor: Nicki Wood Mondays 5:00pm-6:00pm Cost: \$80 (6 week course)

Life Drawing Group

Model poses are held for no longer than 20 minutes at a time. Artists are responsible for bringing any art supplies, canvases, drawing pads, brushes, or pencils that they would like to use.
