Intermediate Mid-Fire

Adults / Ages 13+

Wed. 4:30pm-6pm Mar 27-May 1 Cost: \$205 (6 week course)

In this course, potters will enhance their knowledge of clay processes by implementing their skills from Beginning Wheel Throwing to work with mid-fire clay body and glazes. Students moving into intermediate wheel throwing should be able to throw consistent cylinders on the wheel with about 1lb. of clay and demonstrate control over shaping and trimming their piece.

Advanced Mid-Fire

Adults (16+)

Wed. 6:45pm-8:45pm Mar 27-May 1

Cost: \$205 (6 week course)

Experience alterations, additions, and other high level wheel throwing techniques. This class will give students the chance to work with mid-fire clay body and glazes. Students moving into advanced wheel throwing should be able to throw with 3–5 lbs of clay while demonstrating ability to join various thrown shapes into a finished, shaped and trimmed piece.
