Big Ideas Studio - ASD

Our artists will work on developing an original and authentic artistic voice by gaining foundational instruction in the elements and principles of art and design while gaining experience in as many different art mediums as possible.

PAINTED PAPER BUTTERFLIES

Saturday, March 29th 10am-11am Ages 3-10 | \$15
