Cost: \$95 (6-week course)

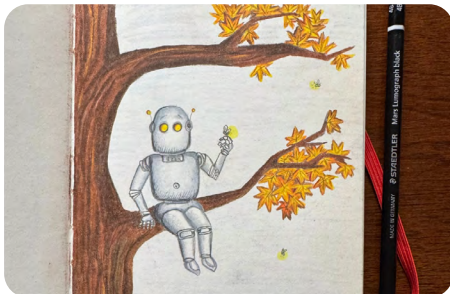

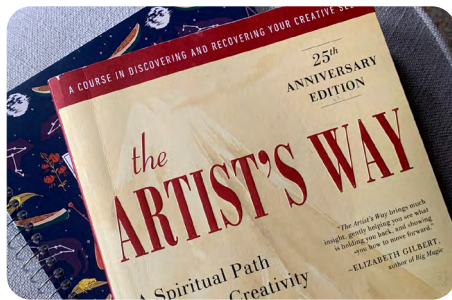
### Adult Drawing I
