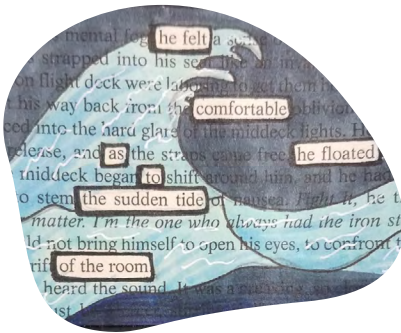


SUNFLOWER CLAY EARRINGS
