


LEARN TO WEAVE

OUT OF THIS WORLD PAINT-A-LONG


Friday, April 10th 6pm-8pm

THE ART OF RAKU FIRING

2-Day Workshop: April 11 9am-3pm & April 25 9am-3pm

Experience the ancient Japanese technique of raku firing, a fast, low-temperature process that creates dramatic crackle patterns, metallic effects, and smoky finishes. This two-day workshop is open to beginners and experienced artists. Students will build hand-formed clay pieces in the first class, then glaze and fire them in an outdoor raku kiln during the second session.



MISHIMA: THE ART OF INLAY

This two-hour workshop offers a creative and focused introduction to Mishima, a beautiful technique used to create crisp, precise designs. Participants will learn to incise lines or patterns into the clay surface and inlay a contrasting colored slip or underglaze to achieve clean, high contrast decoration. Work pieces are prepared in advance, allowing participants to maximize time on the design and inlay process.
