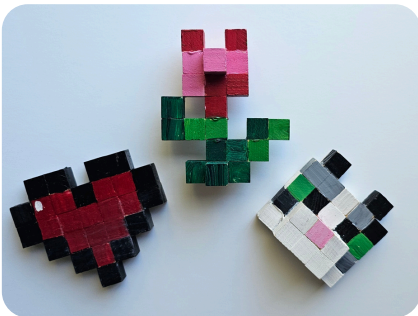


## Saturday Morning Art Club: Pixelated Sculptures

### Traditional Batik

**2 Days: Fri, June 12<sup>th</sup> 6pm-8pm + Sat, June 13<sup>th</sup> 2pm-4pm**

Step into one of the world's most beautiful art forms. In this two-day workshop, artists will explore traditional batik techniques inspired by Java, transforming fabric into intricate designs. Using a tjanting tool, students will draw with hot wax to create resist patterns, then build color through layered dye techniques. This process-driven experience rewards patience as each piece evolves with unique textures and color.



### Warhammer Miniature Painting

**2 Options: Sat, June 13<sup>th</sup> 2pm-4pm / Sat, July 18<sup>th</sup> 10am-12pm**  
**Ages 13-adult | \$50 | Instructor: Bryce Watson**

Step into miniature painting and bring your first Warhammer figure to life. In this beginner-friendly workshop, students will assemble and paint a model from start to finish while learning essential techniques. We'll cover building, brush control, paint application, and adding depth and detail. By the end, you'll leave with a finished miniature and the skills to keep going.

### Relief Printmaking

Use linoleum and carving tools to create your own relief print. After planning and carving, there's nothing quite like pulling your very first print. It's a little bit of magic every time. You'll take home both your finished print and your carved block. We'll cover how to create a strong black-and-white (binary) image, transfer designs onto linoleum, learn basic carving techniques, and pull prints using simple hand-pressing methods.

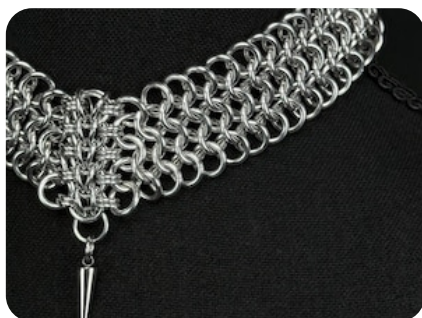


### Yoga and Art: Finding Your Radiance

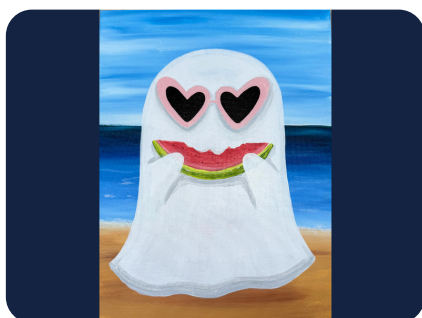


### Chainmail Jewelry: 4-in-1 Weave

### Summerween Paint-A-Long

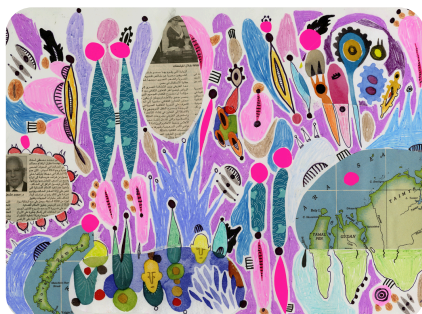
**Saturday, July 18<sup>th</sup> 12pm-2:30pm**

You'll leave with a whimsical, ready-to-hang piece that brings gentle sound and movement to any space.

### The Rhythmic Line: Sensory Carving

**Saturday, June 6<sup>th</sup> 10am–12pm**

**Adults (15+) | \$80 | Instructor: Ruth Hesse**

This two-hour workshop offers a creative and focused introduction to sgraffito, a beautiful technique of scratching through an outer layer of color to reveal the clay body beneath. This process allows for spontaneous design, intricate illustration, and personal expression. Each student will be given two small tumblers. Pieces are prepared in advance, allowing you to maximize your time focusing purely on carving and design elements.



### Clay Owl Vases

**Saturday, June 13<sup>th</sup> 6pm–8pm**

**Adults (16+) | \$55 | Instructor: Kris Potter**

Join us as we create a custom owl vase from a slab of clay! Each participant will learn the basic skills of handbuilding as we walk you through step-by-step in creating a unique ceramic owl-shaped vase. The instructor will complete the glazing and firings. Completed pieces will be ready for pick-up within 4-weeks after the class.



### Clay Speaker Frogs

Turn your phone into a surprisingly powerful speaker... with a frog? Build a ceramic "Speaker Frog" designed to naturally amplify your phone's sound. After class, your frog will be glazed and kiln-fired by the instructor. Create a fun piece that's both functional and fun!



### Paint an Oklahoma Sunset

You'll have the tools to create your own unique sunset painting while learning core acrylic techniques along the way.
